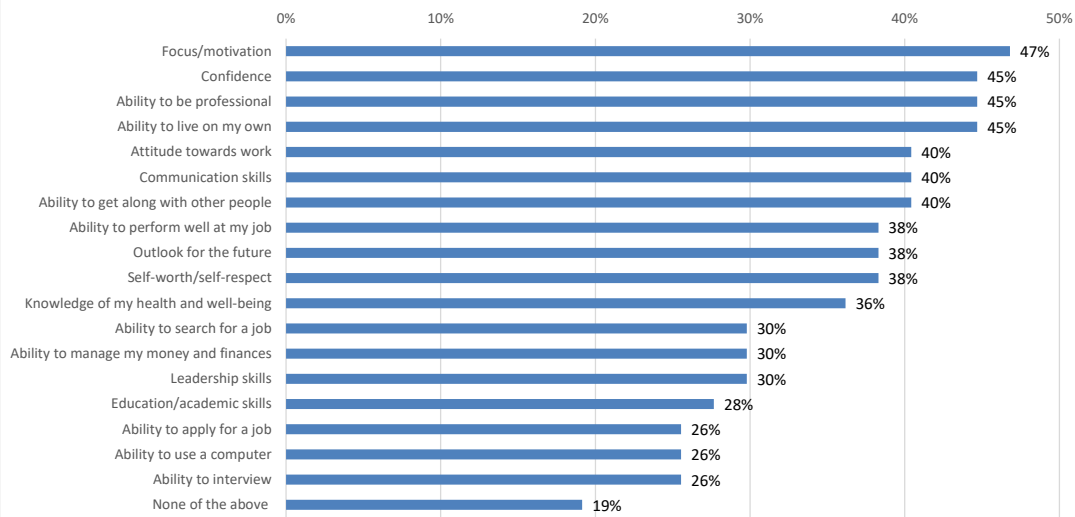

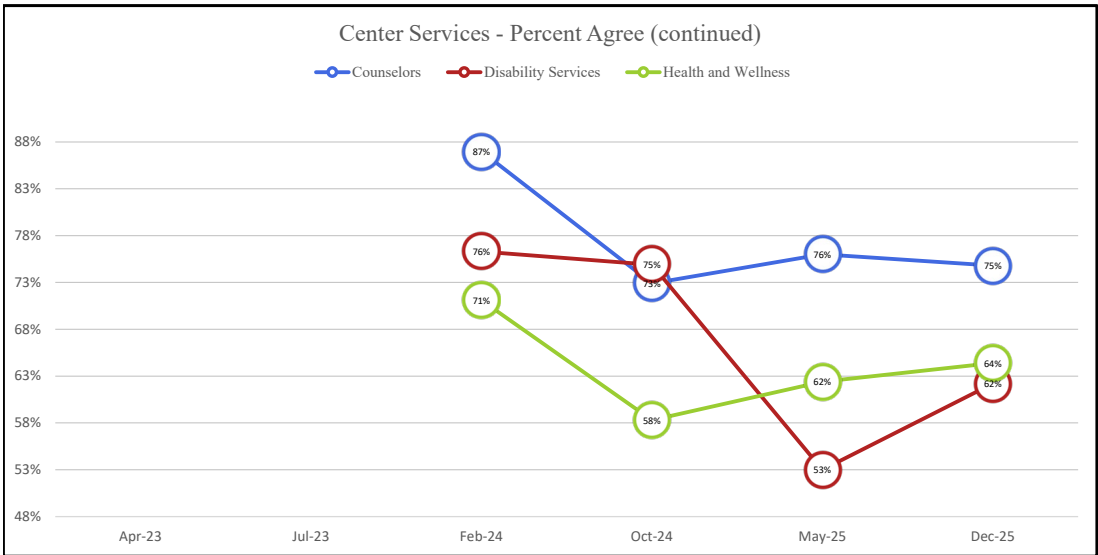
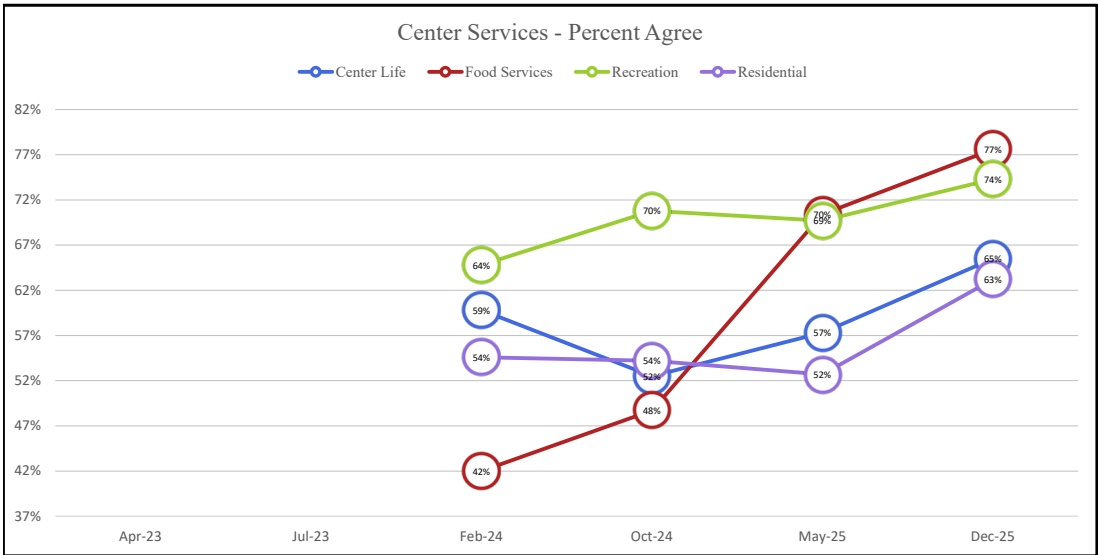
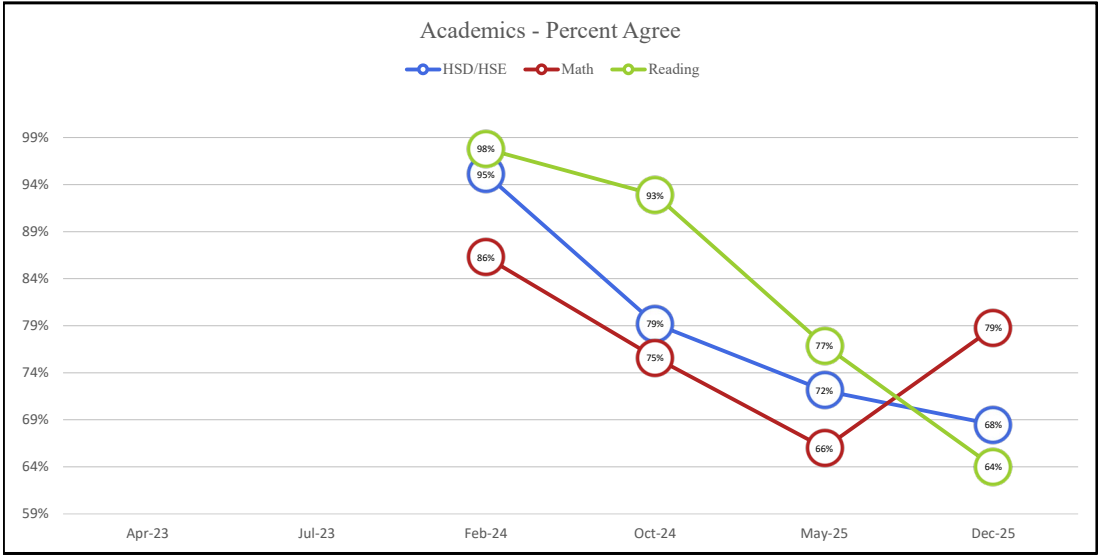
### Causes for Difficulties in Reading Class
