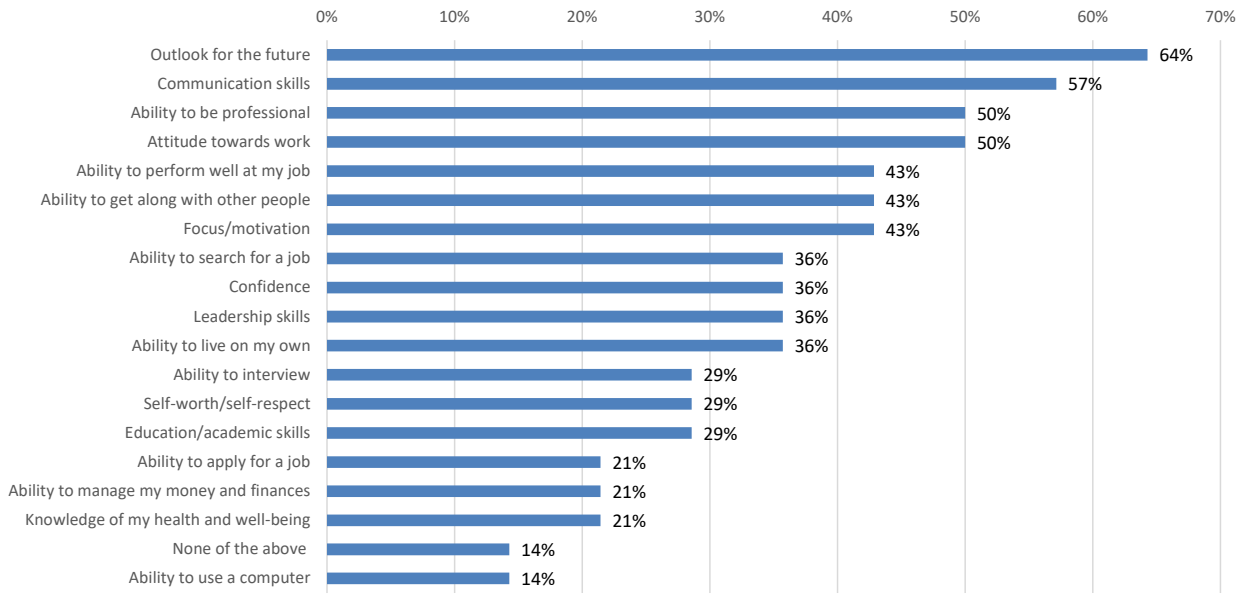

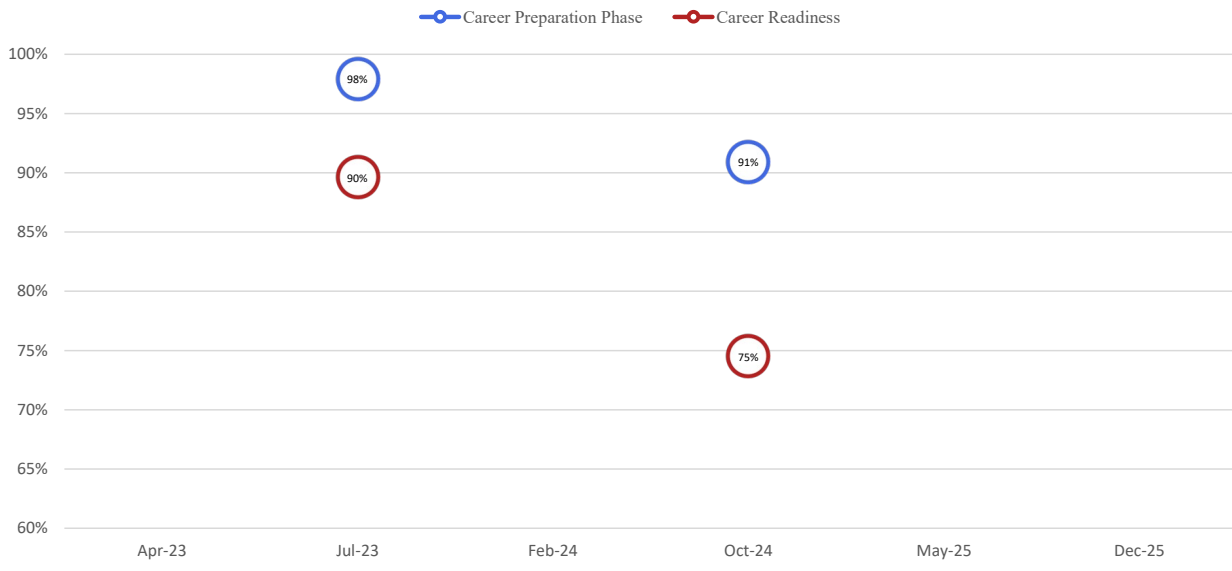

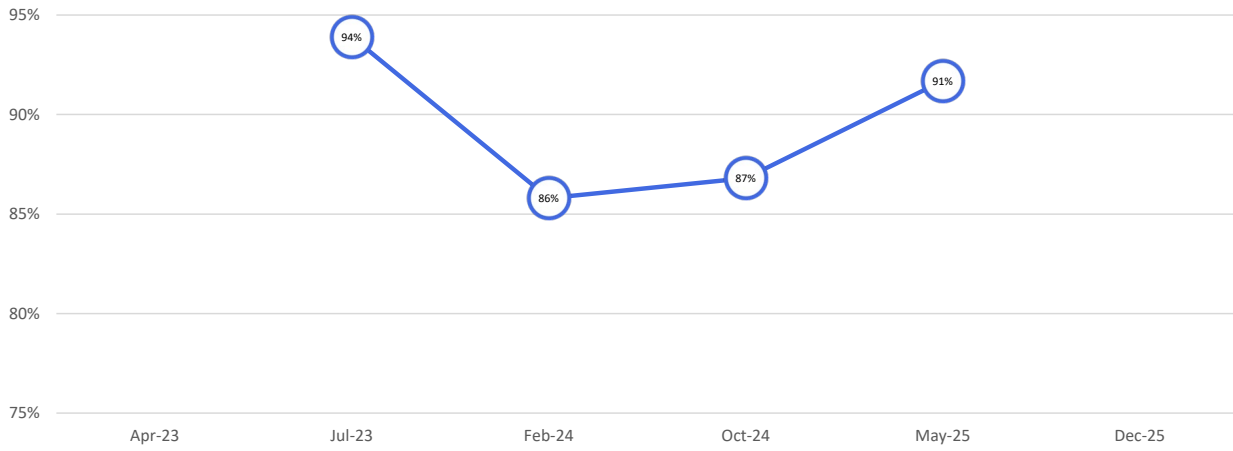


Career Success - Percent Agree



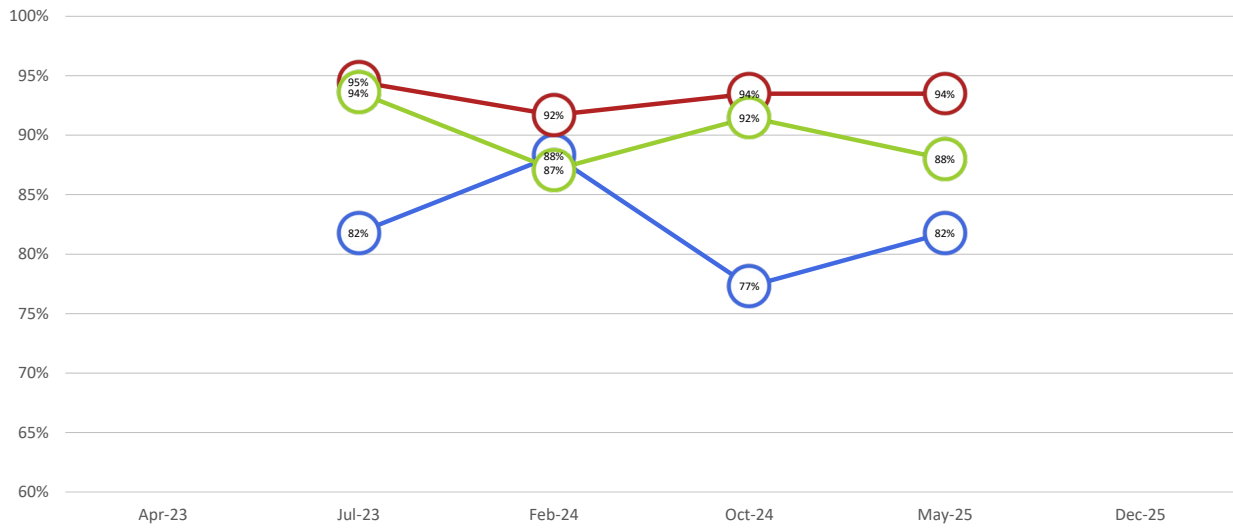
Career Technical Training - Percent Agree

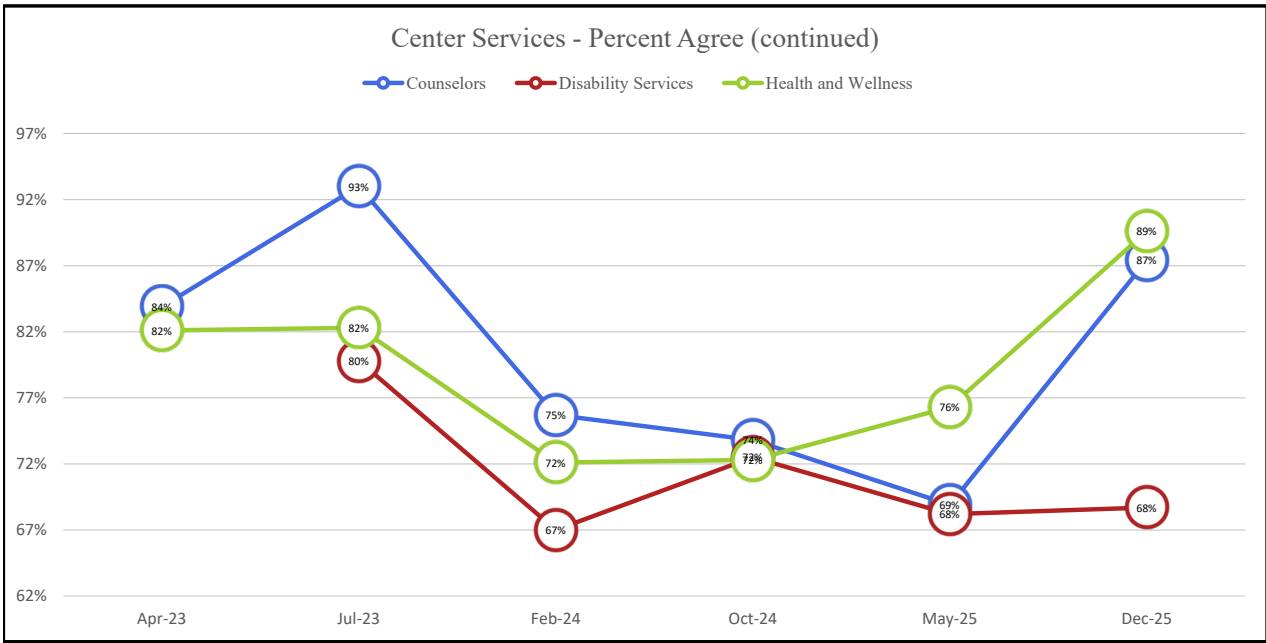
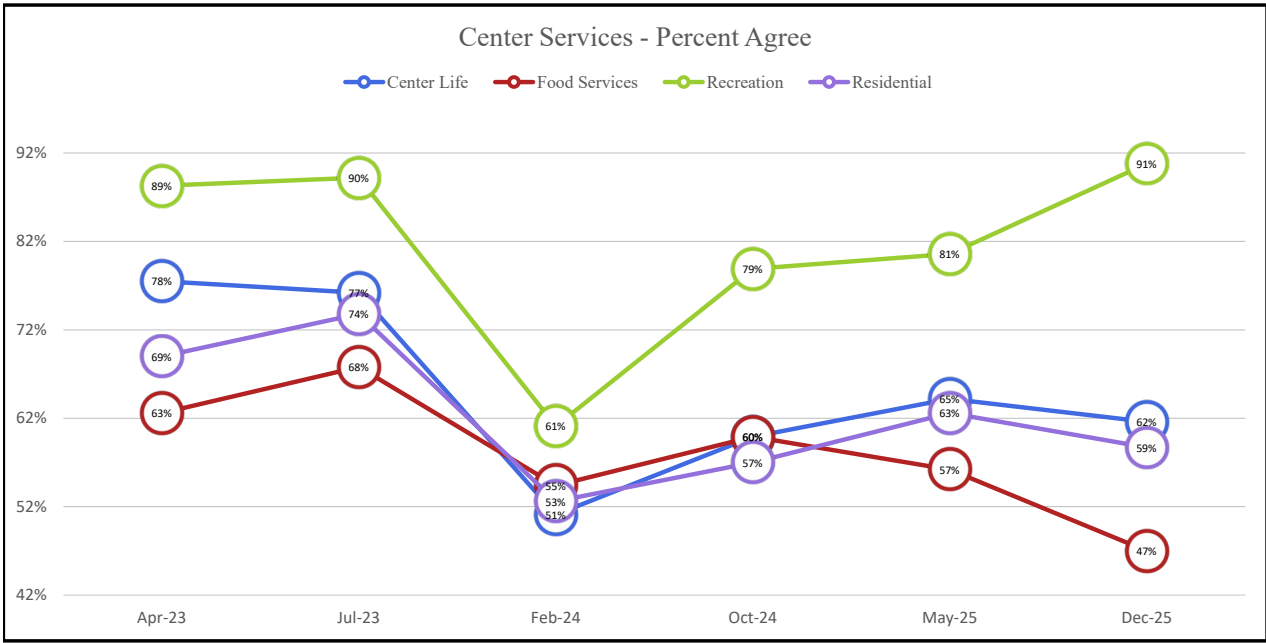
—○ Career Technical Training: Basic
