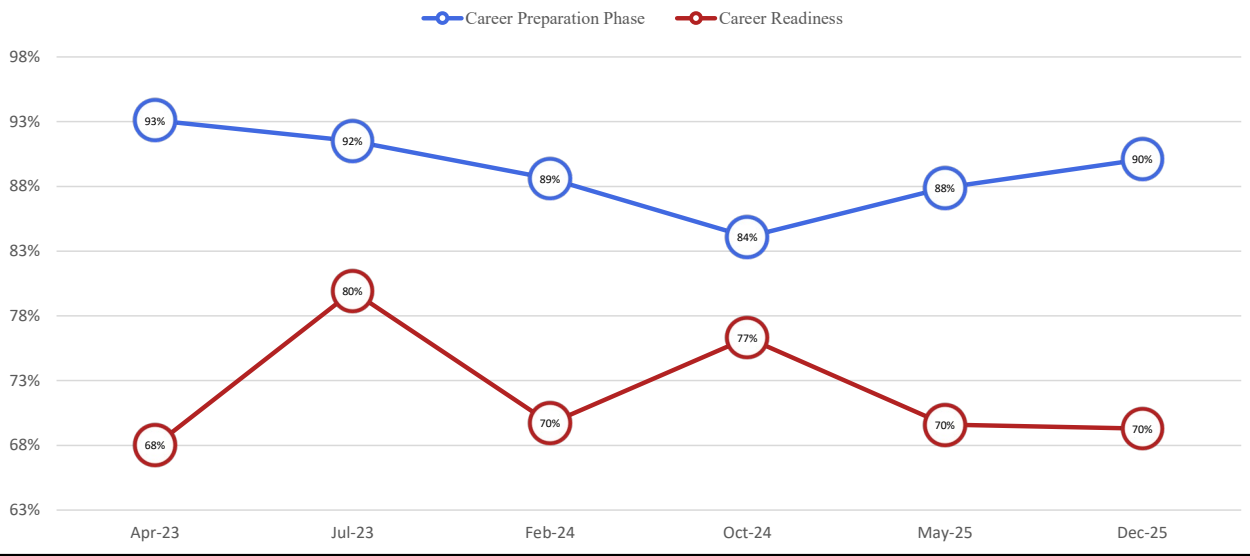

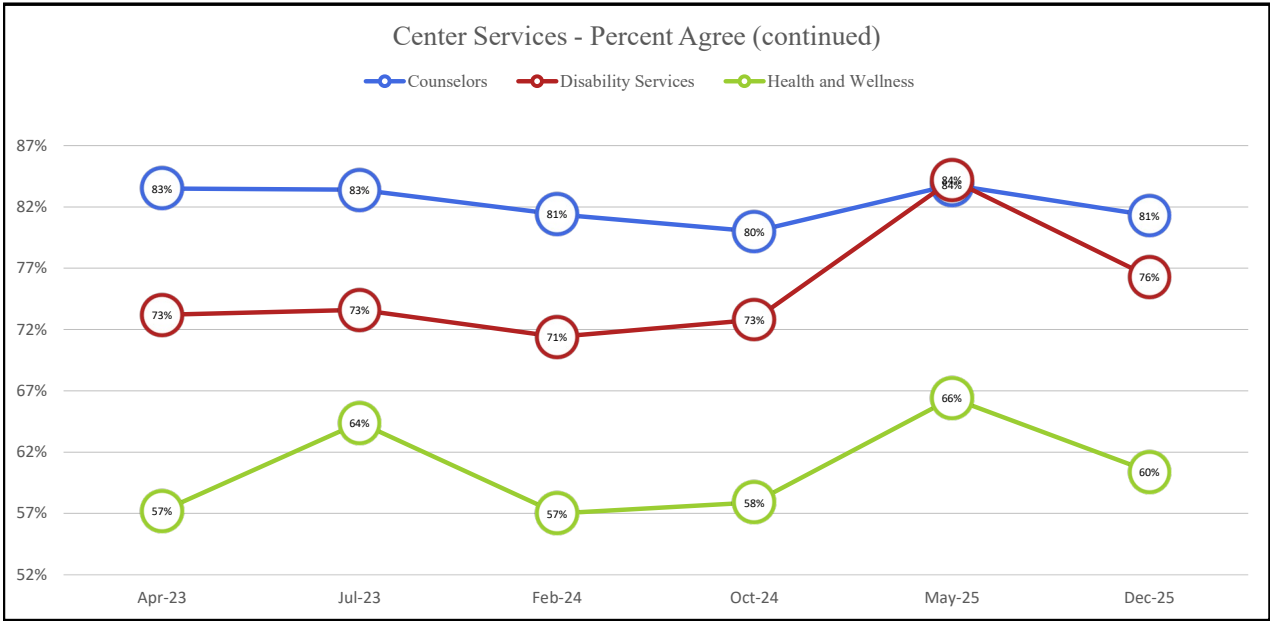
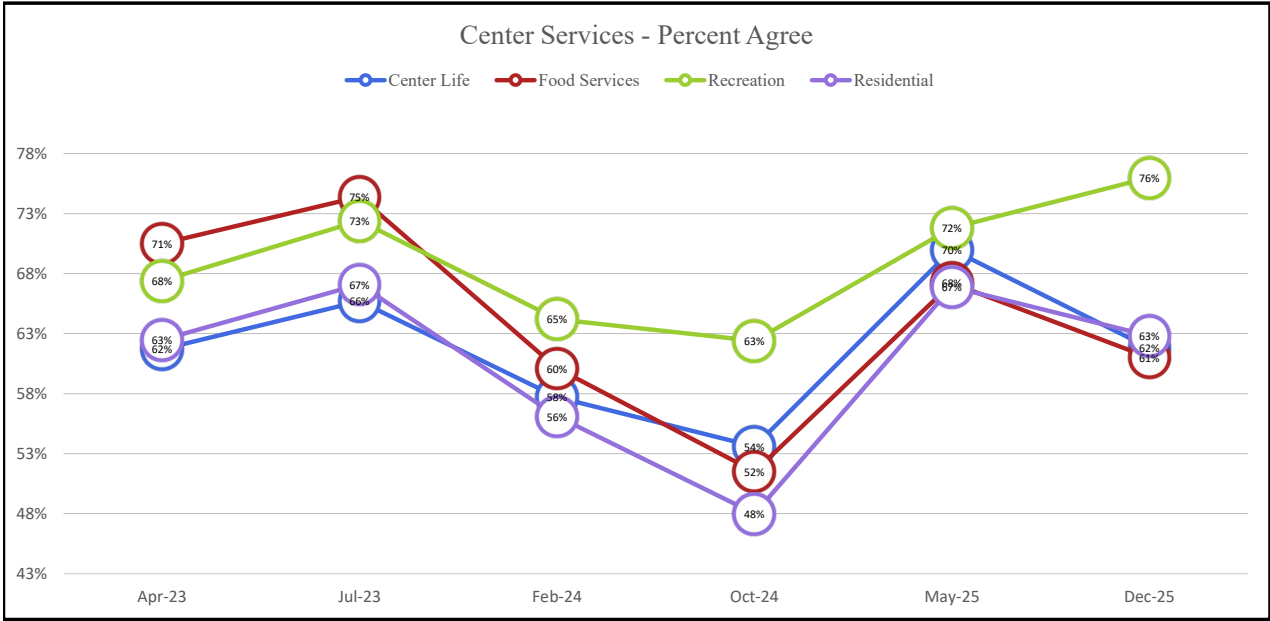
### Job Corps Improved my Skills
