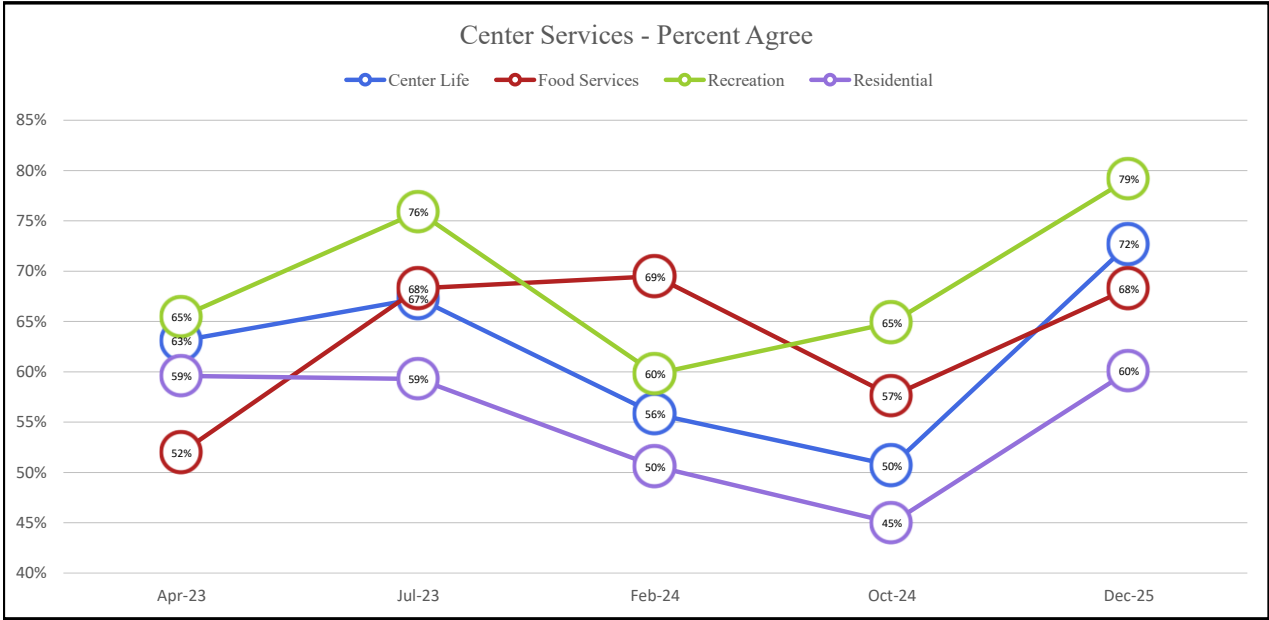
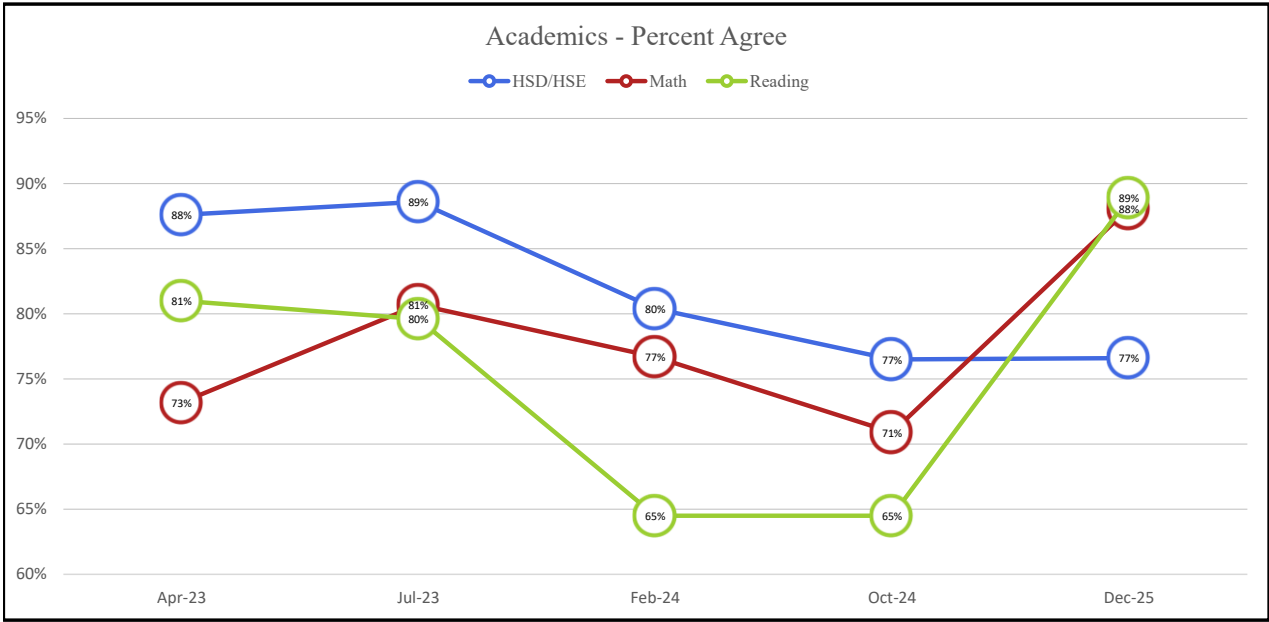
Dorm Safety Issues



Job Corps Improved my Skills

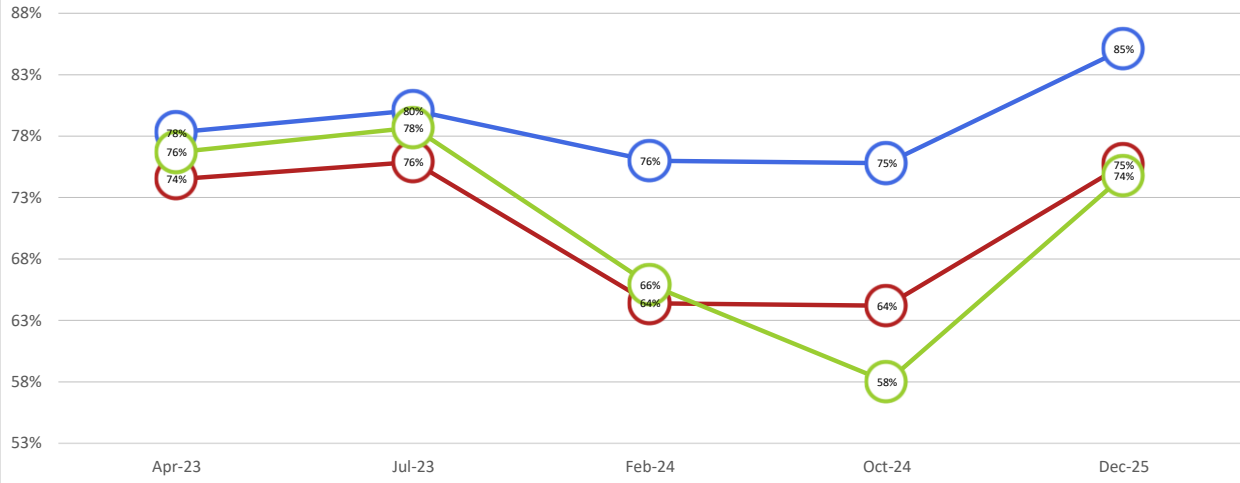
