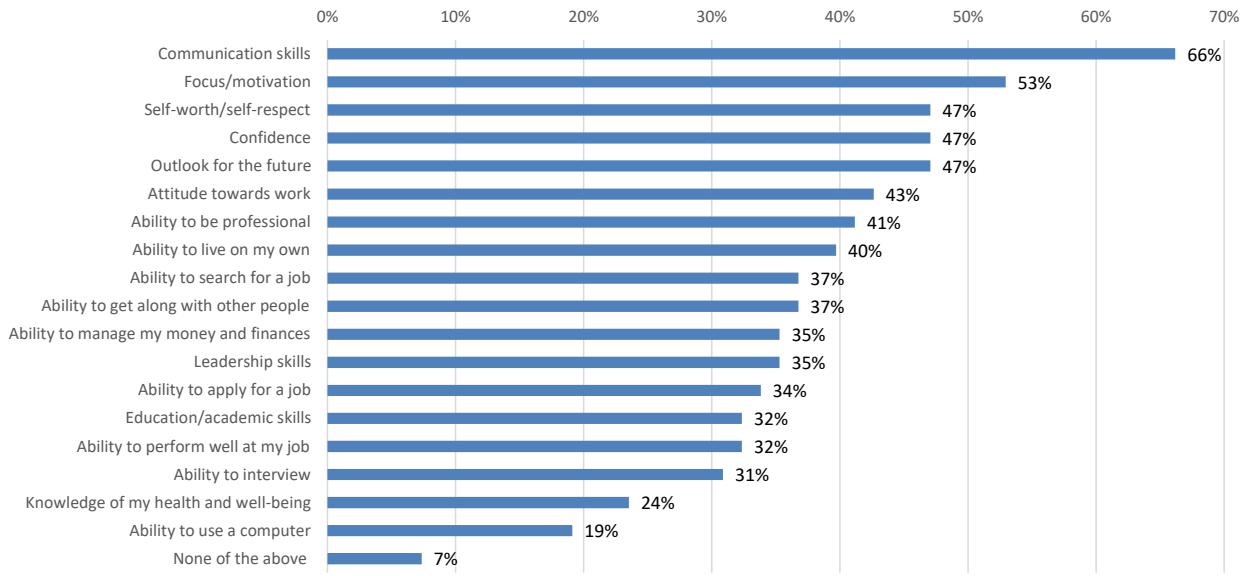

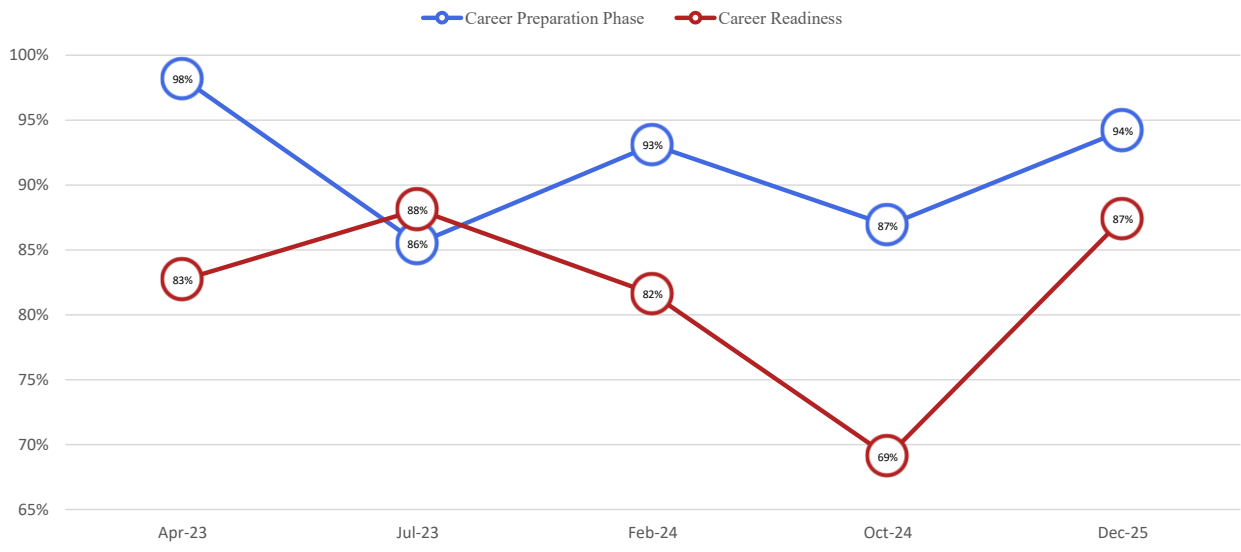

### Career Success - Percent Agree



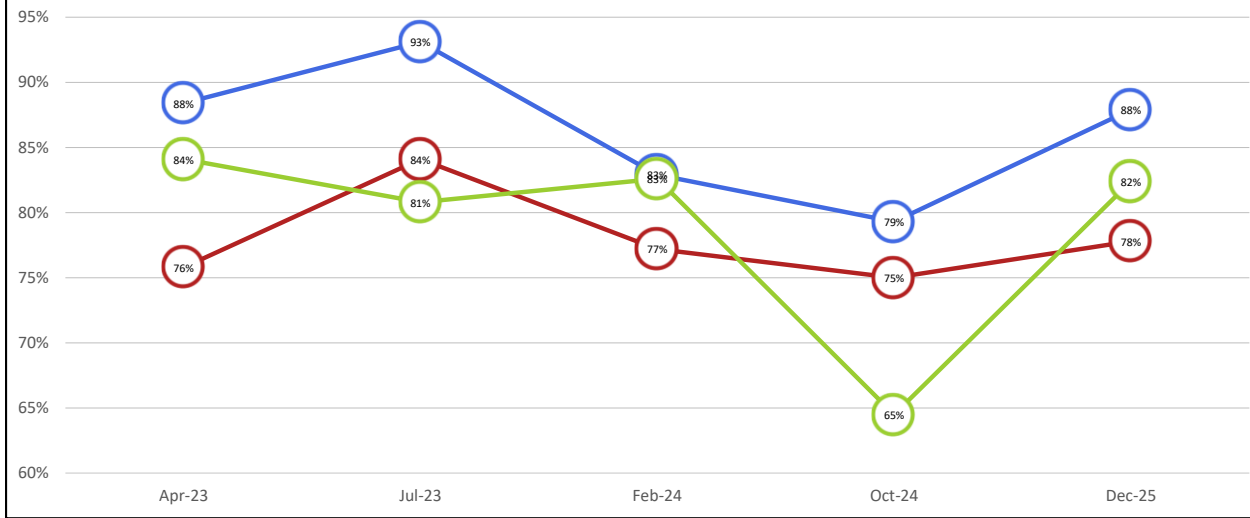

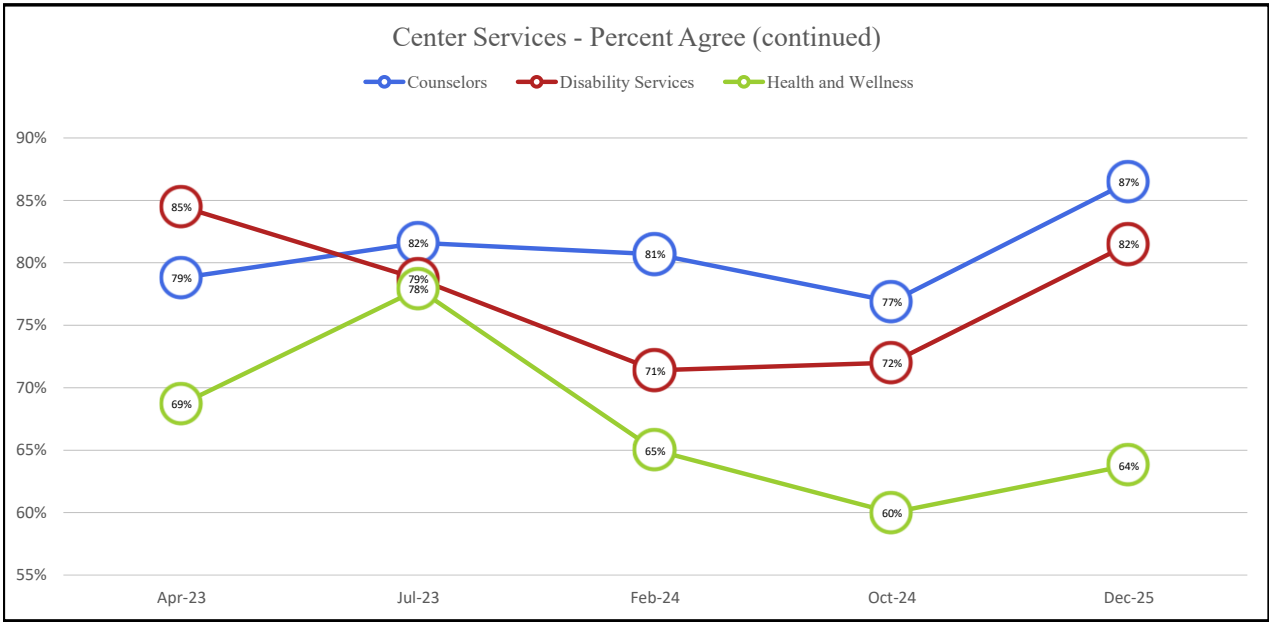
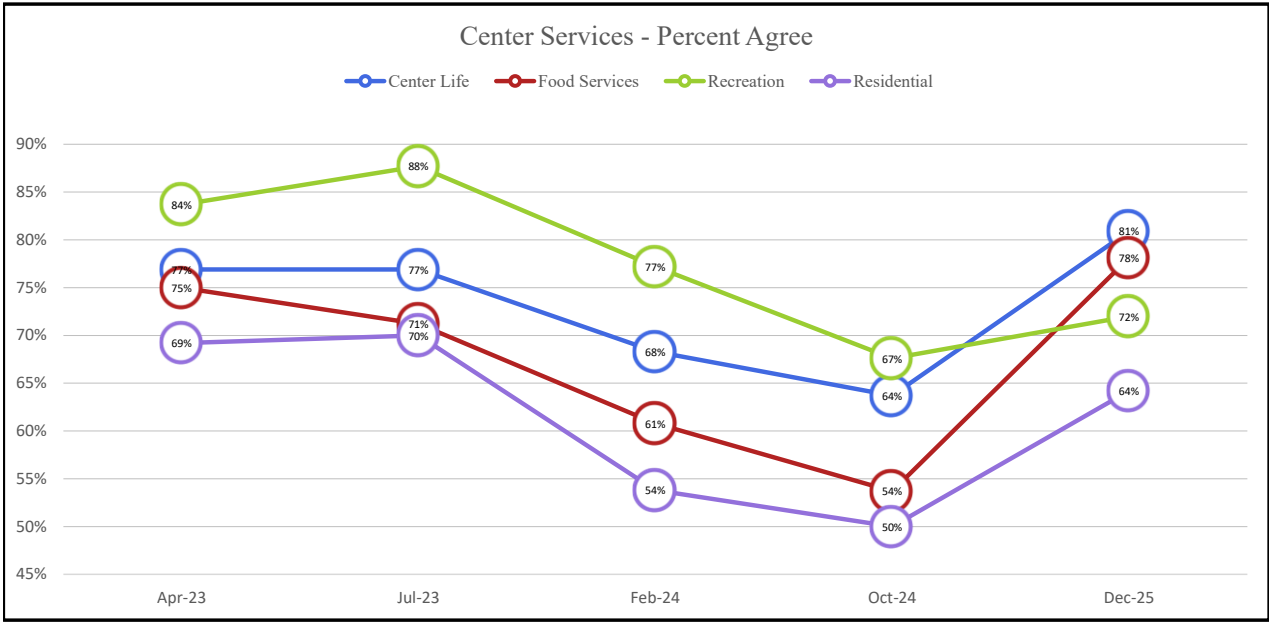
