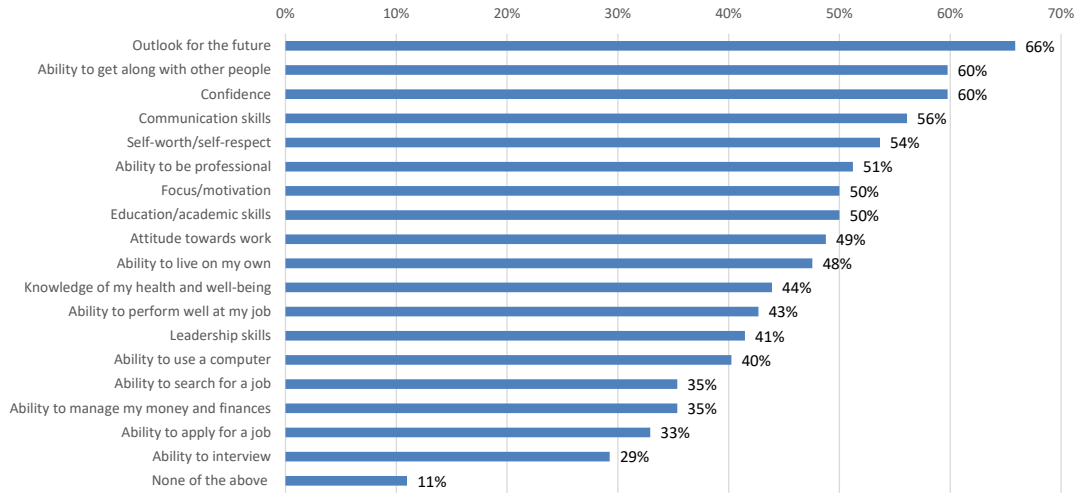

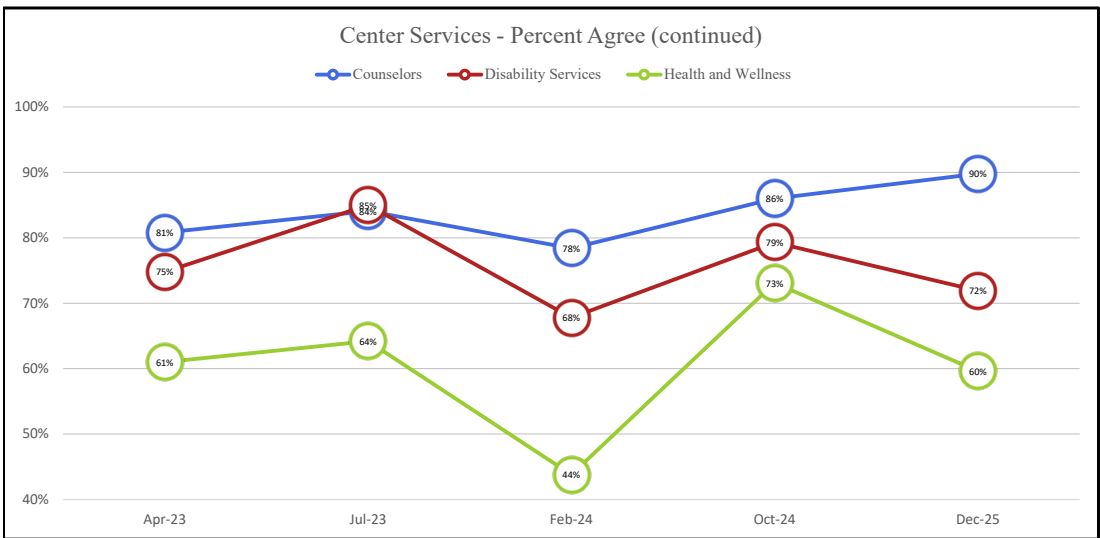
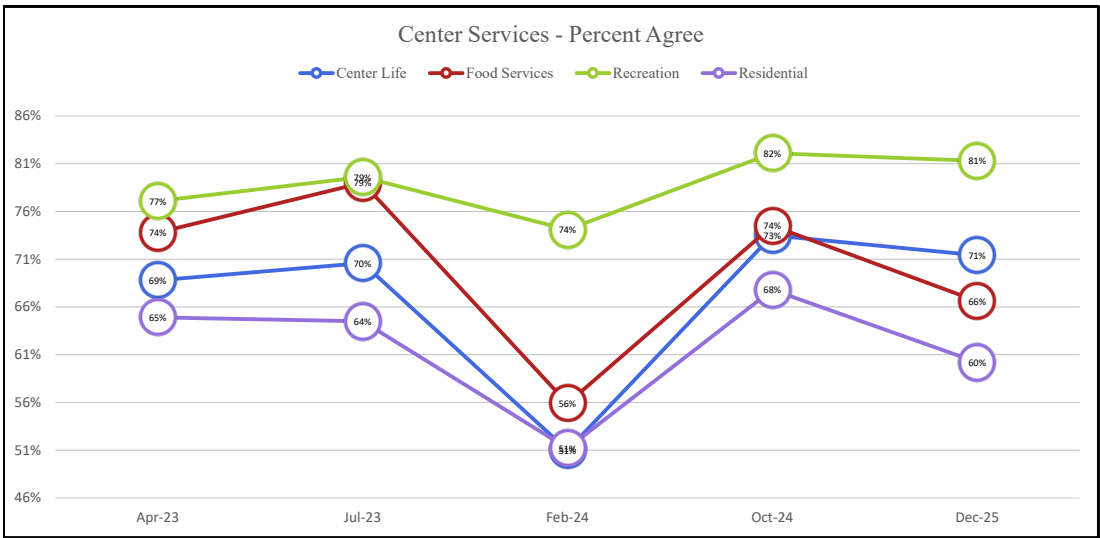
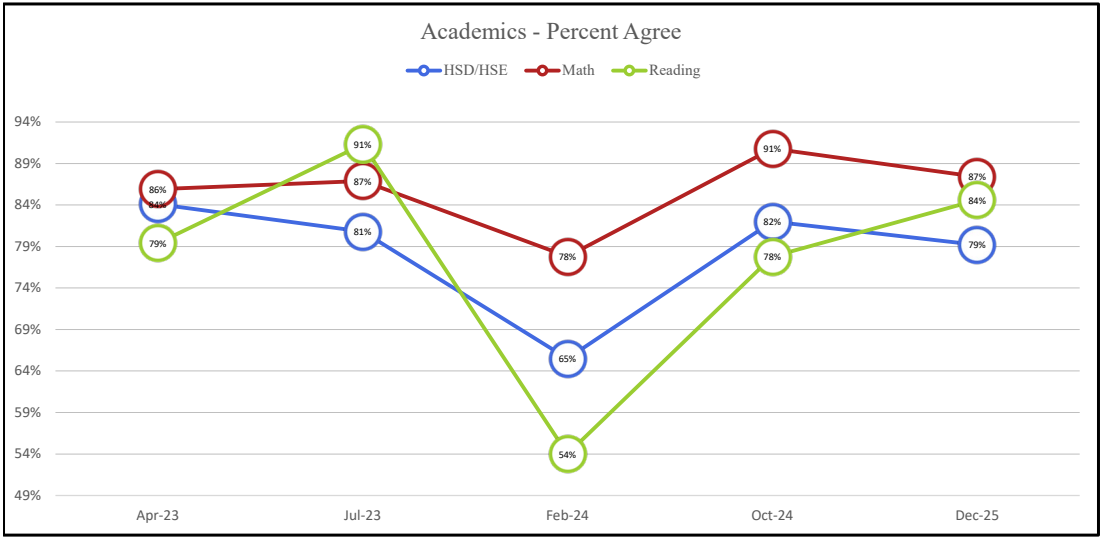
### Dorm Safety Issues
